DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED DISCHARGE: The application seeks coverage for stormwater discharges from construction activities under the NPDES Construction General permit.

SUMMARY OF REQUEST: The Department of Environmental Services (SCDES) is currently reviewing the application for an NPDES Stormwater permit and Coastal Zone Consistency certification associated with 1.6 acres of proposed land disturbance to facilitate the demolition of existing structure and associated pavement, perform archaeological site investigation and recovery, and installation of test piles for a future student housing project.
