

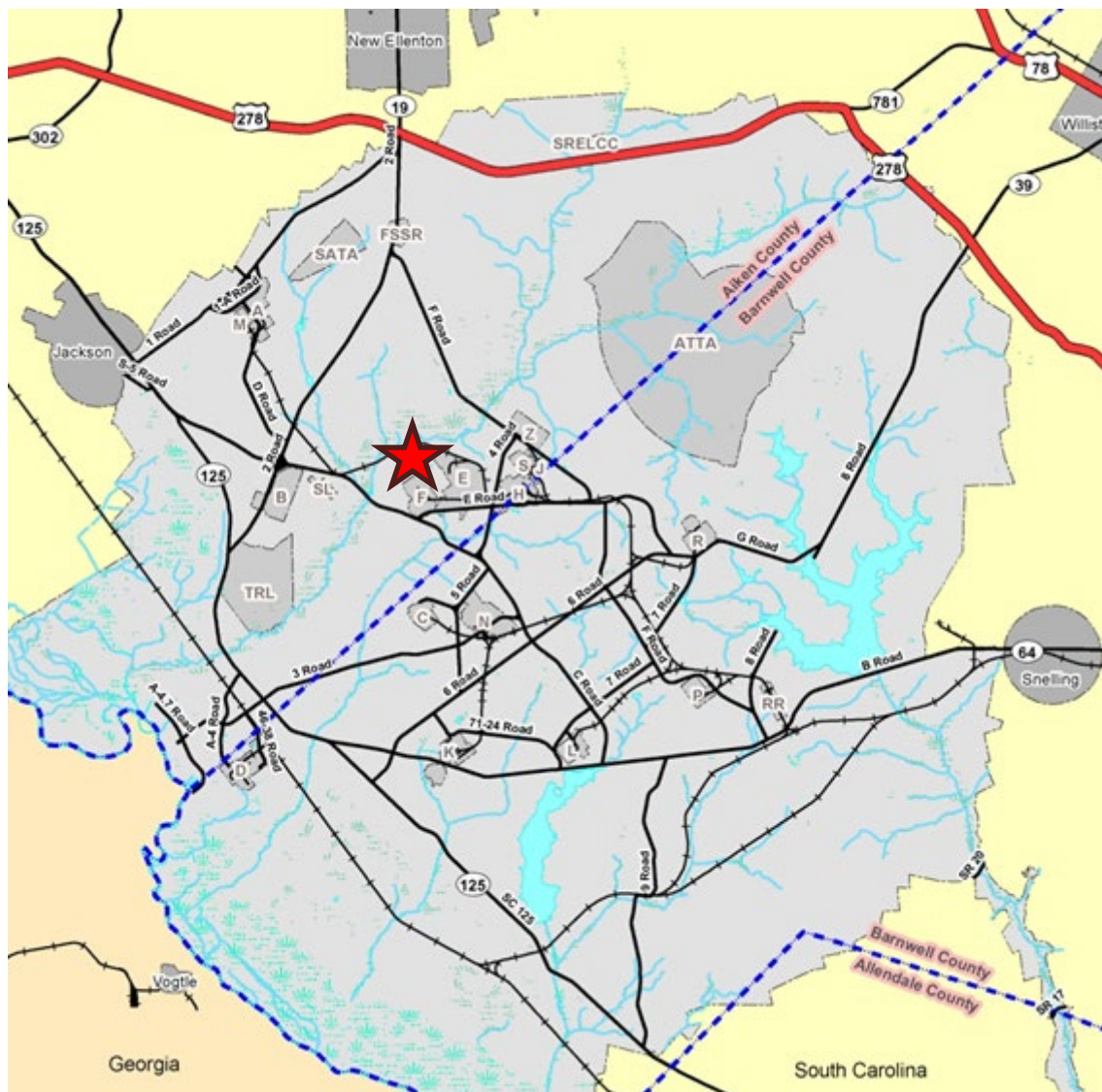

### RECEIPT OF A RCRA PERMIT APPLICATION FOR THE SAVANNAH RIVER PLUTONIUM PROCESSING FACILITY

**SAVANNAH RIVER SITE

The South Carolina Department of Environmental Services (SCDES) received a Resource Conservation Recovery Act (RCRA) Permit Application for storage of hazardous and mixed waste at the proposed Savannah River Plutonium Processing Facility (SRPPF) to be located in the F-Area on the Savannah River Site (SRS) in Aiken County.



The Permit Application was submitted on January 30, 2026, along with the Location Standards Compliance Demonstration required for new hazardous waste facilities. This submittal incorporates new information specific to the SRPPF RCRA Facility and minor updates to Volume I - General Information.

The SRPPF RCRA permit, if issued, would allow the storage of hazardous and mixed waste generated at the SRPPF until such waste can be sent for treatment or disposition at another facility. Mixed waste contains a hazardous component as defined by RCRA and a radioactive component. The radioactive component of these wastes may be either transuranic (TRU) or low-level radioactive waste. The SRPPF would consist of five buildings, an existing building [731-2F] and four newly constructed waste storage buildings [243-1F, 243-2F, 243-4F, 243-5F]. The RCRA Permit would not regulate the plutonium processing activities.
