NOTICE PURPOSE & PUBLIC HEARING TOPIC: The Department of Environmental Services (SCDES) is seeking input on the proposed application from Mungo Homes to disturb land to facilitate construction of 65 single family homes as well as associated roads and infrastructure. SCDES invites interested people to an informational session, public hearing, and/or to provide written comments. The informational public meeting will include:

- SCDES's role in the proposed application and applicable regulatory requirements for the pending application
- Scope of the proposed project and brief description of stormwater controls for the site

This notice provides additional opportunity for public participation and community engagement as the previous public meeting and hearing on September 29, 2025 were affected by forecasts for potential impacts from Tropical Storm Imelda and transitioned to a virtual event.

All previously submitted written and oral comments, including those during the September 29 virtual hearing, will be considered in SCDES's decision making process.

- Procedures: An informational public meeting to share information and answer questions will begin at 6 pm and will be followed by a formal public hearing beginning at 7 pm. The hearing will be conducted by a hearing officer. Oral and written comments will be accepted. Oral presentations may be limited to a fixed, reasonable amount of time. The number of representatives that may make oral statements on behalf of any individual or organized group may be limited.

 hearing date to discuss any special aids or services required.

PERMIT SUMMARY: SCDES is currently reviewing the application for an NPDES Stormwater permit which proposes 39.6 acres of land disturbance for the construction of a single-family residential subdivision and



associated infrastructure. Since this site is located in a coastal county, the applications require SCDES's Bureau of Coastal Management to review the project for consistency with the South Carolina Coastal Zone Management Plan.
