SOUTH CAROLINA WASTE TIRE COLLECTION, PROCESSING AND DISPOSAL FACILITY'S ANNUAL REPORT FORM

PURPOSE: All Waste Tire collectors, processors and disposal facilities are to use this form to report all activities during the last year.

EXPLANATION AND DEFINITION:

All registered waste tire collectors, processors and disposal facility's owners must submit an annual report to the Department. This report is a summary of the activities in the previous year. Such as:

- 1. The type and number of waste tires received during year
- 2. The type of waste tires, with name and location of where the tires were shipped
- 3. And the type and quantity of waste tires on site January 1st of the current year

The waste tire collectors, processors and disposal facility must report all activities during the previous year starting with March 1st of the previous year and ending with the last day of February in the current year. The Division of Compliance and Enforcement must receive this report, annually, prior to March 1st.

ITEM BY ITEM INSTRUCTIONS - Print or type:

- 1. The year covered by this report
- 2. The waste tire collection / processing and disposal facility's ID assigned by the Department
- 3. The complete the name of the Facility submitting the annual report
- 4. The county where the Facility is located
- 5. The address of the Facility's location
- 6. The city, state, and zip code for the Facility's location
- 7. The name of the owner of the Facility
- 8. The mailing address of the Facility if different than the location address
- 9. The city, state, and zip code for the Facility if different than the location address
- 10. The Facility's phone number
- 11. The Facility's fax number
- 12. The Facility's E-mail address
