Also, eleven (11) Administrative Orders with total assessed civil penalties in the amount of twenty-one thousand, ten dollars (\$21,010.00) were reported during this period.

Summary: Pavan Parth, LLC (Individual/Entity) owns underground storage tanks (USTs) in Greenwood County, South Carolina. On April 19, 2024, the Department conducted a routine inspection of the Facility and issued a Notice of Alleged Violation. The Individual/Entity has violated the SUPERB Act and the South Carolina Underground Storage Tank Regulation, as follows: failed to train Class C Operators before they assume responsibility for the UST Facility and failure to designate in writing a list of Class C operators; failed to validate that monthly and annual requirements had been performed and to physically visit each facility at least once a quarter; failed to test spill prevention equipment at least once every three (3) years; failed to test release detection equipment annually; failed to conduct an annual line tightness test on pressurized lines or have monthly monitoring; failed to conduct an annual test of line leak detectors; failed to conduct proper release detection using an automatic tank gauge (ATG); failed to properly maintain tank release detection equipment; failed to maintain and operate a corrosion protection system; and failed to provide an adequate release detection method.

<u>Action</u>: The Individual/Entity is required to submit: list of Class C operators trained and designated for the Facility; proof a Walkthrough Inspection Log has been initiated and is being properly maintained; current passing spill bucket integrity test results for all spill buckets

associated with the USTs/compartments at the Facility; current passing release detection equipment operability test results for all the USTs/compartments at the Facility; current passing line tightness test results for all USTs/compartments at the Facility; current passing line leak detector function check results for all the USTs/compartments at the Facility; proof that the ATG probe for the 4,000-gallon diesel compartment has been repaired and/or replaced and passing follow-up ATG results; proof the metal components in the under-dispenser containment sump associated with the dispenser 9/10 are isolated from soil and/or water; and either the most recent ten (10) out of twelve (12) months of ATG records with the most recent two (2) months passing for the 4,000-gallon diesel compartment or passing tank tightness test results and current passing ATG record for the 4,000-gallon diesel compartment. The Department has assessed a total civil penalty in the amount of twenty-one thousand, ten dollars (\$21,010.00). The Individual/Entity shall pay a civil penalty in the amount of twenty-one thousand, ten dollars (\$21,010.00).
