

THINK BEFORE YOU BURN!

OPEN BURNING AFFECTS US ALL

Legal to Burn

- Yard Trimmings
- Barbecues
- Outdoor Fireplaces (using only untreated wood)
- Campfires (using only untreated wood)
- Bonfires



If burning, remember to always:

- Actively watch the fire;
- Have water or other fire extinguishing measures readily available;
- Comply with county and local ordinances; and
- Notify S.C. Forestry Commission of any outdoor burning.

Illegal to Burn

- Paper and cardboard
- Roofing materials
- Heating oil
- Tires and rubber products
- Household cleaners
- Farm chemicals
- Plastics
- Paint
- Electrical wires
- Insulation and duct work
- Garbage
- Treated wood
- Painted/stained wood
