Course Objective

The purpose of this training is for users to learn how to invite additional people to be users on the same site in the ePermitting system. To invite additional users to view, edit, or administer information in the ePermitting system, click in the Select Site *(or All)* box on the left side of the screen and select/locate the site the users will have access to. It may be useful to have additional users if other people interact with the Site *(e.g., Billing, Administrative)* or for times when the initial user is unavailable *(e.g., vacation, change of position)*.
